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Health Services Administration -AAB Degree Step-Up Scholarship Deadline September 7, 2021

The Health Services Administration (HSA) AAB Associate Degree Step-Up Scholarship is intended for qualified graduates, from the Valley College Health Services Administration AAB Associate Degree program, who enrolls in the Valley College Health Services Administration Bachelor degree program offered online. This scholarship is designed to encourage the graduate to further their education and develop additional technical, communication, and managerial skills that can lead to more employment opportunities. The applicant is considered a candidate for the scholarship during his or her enrollment in the degree program.

Timing of award and award amount is as follows:

This scholarship is a tuition and fees, last dollar scholarship and will consist of the cost of the program tuition and fees minus any grants (federal or state) received by the student. This scholarship has no cash equivalency and will not be applied to any previous balance that the student may have with Valley College.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Enrollment in a Valley College HSA Bachelor degree program offered online. The student should start their program on or before September 7, 2021.
2. Must have started the Health Services Administration AAB Degree program between the periods of March 1, 2018 through February 28, 2019 and graduated from the program but has not found gainful employment in their field.
3. Complete the scholarship application including an essay question by the September 7, 2021 deadline.
4. This scholarship cannot be combined with any other Valley College scholarships.
5. Failure to complete/graduate from the degree program for any reason will lead to forfeiture of the scholarship award.

Application Procedure:

1. Meet with the Financial Aid office to discuss financing options.
2. The prospective students may obtain the appropriate application from the Valley College Financial Aid office during the admissions process.
3. Complete the application which includes an essay question. All information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant.

Submission Procedure:

The completed application must be submitted to the Financial Aid Department. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. The Financial Aid Advisor will forward all completed applications to the Campus Director. The final approval is granted by the Director of Financial Aid.
