Valley College Celebration Step Up Scholarship

The Valley College Celebration Step Up Scholarship award has been modified for the Diploma – Bachelor step up.

The purpose of this scholarship is to celebrate the recent Hilbert College/ Valley College acquisition. The intent of the scholarship is to offer the opportunity to graduates of Valley College to continue their education and broaden their career path opportunities. Students who graduated from a Valley College diploma program, for-credit certificate program, or Associate Degree program and enroll in a Valley College Associate or Bachelor degree program that is delivered 100% online are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The applicant is considered a candidate for the scholarship during their enrollment in the degree program. The qualifying programs are administered through Valley College – Martinsburg (WV).

Total program tuition will be determined after the credit evaluation has been completed by Valley College. The amount and timing of the award will be determined by the College Financial Aid department and posted on the student’s award letter. The chart below shows the timing and amount of the award if the student does not have any credit transfers and must complete the entire program.

Credential	Amount of Award	Timing of the Award
Diploma-Associate	\$4,000	\$4,000.00 will be awarded upon successful completion of the program.
Associate-Bachelor	\$4,000	\$2,000.00 will be awarded upon successful completion of each academic year.
Diploma-Bachelor	\$8,000	Students follow the two steps above. Step 1, complete the Diploma-Associate Degree program to earn \$4,000 program award. Step 2, matriculate into the Bachelor's Degree program* and earn as noted in Associate-Bachelor line above. Students who follow the MAA/MFOBC, MCA or Cyber Diploma to Bachelor will be awarded \$4,000 upon successful completion of each academic year.

The Valley College Celebration Step Up scholarship will be applied to the account balance owed to Valley College for the program the student is enrolling in. The scholarship has no cash equivalency. It is institutional funding that is applied as a last dollar offset, up to the total amount specified in the award, to the student account balance after all eligible federal, state, and local funding has been disbursed to the student’s account. The scholarship will not be applied to any balance that the student may have with Valley College from a previous program.

Terms and Conditions:

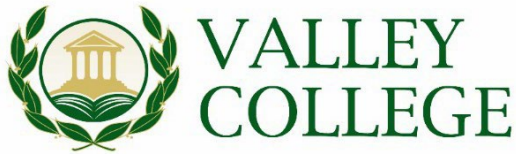
1. Enrollment in a Valley College degree program and administered through the Martinsburg campus
2. Must have graduated from a Valley College diploma (or qualifying certificate) or associate program
3. Complete the scholarship application
4. Failure to graduate from the degree program will lead to forfeiture of scholarship.
5. Diploma-Bachelor: Must matriculate into Bachelor’s degree program in subsequent block following Associate’s completion.

Application Procedure:

1. Meet with the Financial Aid office to discuss financing options.
2. The prospective students may obtain the appropriate application from the Valley College Financial Aid office during the admissions process.
3. Complete the application which includes an essay question. All information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant.

Submission Procedure:

The completed application must be submitted to the Financial Aid Department. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. The Financial Aid Advisor will forward all completed applications to the Campus Director. The final approval is granted by the Director of Financial Aid.

Degree Students	\$2,000	\$1,000.00 will be awarded upon successful completion of each academic year for Associate programs. The Bachelor programs will be awarded upon successful completion of the second and the last academic year.

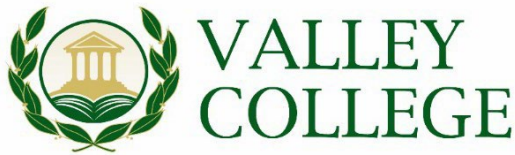

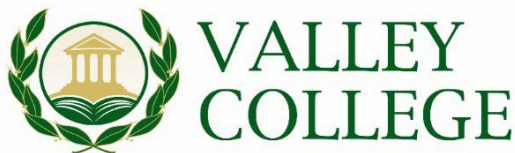

1. Enrollment in a Valley College diploma or degree program either offered at the Cleveland or Fairlawn locations or administered through the Martinsburg campus. Programs offered at the Cleveland or Fairlawn are hybrid programs. The programs administered through the Martinsburg (WV) campus are delivered 100% online.
2. Student must enroll in the program after September 1, 2023.
3. Must be an employee from Senior Arrow Living at time of enrollment.
4. Complete the grant application.
5. Failure to graduate from any program will lead to forfeiture of grant.
