Valley College has revised some of its bookstore policies and updated its uniform charges for programs who must purchase uniforms through the college.

## General Information

The program tables show the direct costs for each program. The student enrollment agreement provides a more in-depth breakdown of tuition, any required fees and estimated additional cost. Indirect costs such as food and housing, personal school supplies, personal and miscellaneous expenses, and transportation are not included in tuition and required fees. ## Explanation of Graduation and Other Fees:

- The Graduation Fee: The Graduation Fee is paid by all graduates of diploma and degree programs for graduation processing, which includes file close out, initial transcript processing, diploma processing, and graduation ceremony; failure to attend ceremony is not grounds for waiver of fee.
- Transcript Processing Fees: The transcript process fee is $\$ 10.00$. More information and Valley College Transcript Request forms are available at https://valley.edu/transcript-request/
- Course Retake Fee: If a student enrolled in a diploma or degree program must retake a course for any reason the student will be charged a flat rate of $\$ 300.00$ for a course retake fee when the student repeats that course.
- Practical Nursing (Ohio) and Nursing Associate Degree (WV): Prior to enrollment, Valley College will pay for the initial HESI Entrance Exam. The applicants are responsible for covering the cost of the HESI Exam retakes. Estimated Cost $\$ 55.00$ per attempt.


## Valley College Bookstore

- Textbooks: Valley College Textbook prices are subject to change. Textbook information is posted on the Valley College website at http://www.valley.edu/consumer-information/ (Look for Valley College Book List by Course). Students who take $100 \%$ online programs and Veterinary programs have the option of ordering many of the textbooks on their own. Practical Nursing and Nursing Associate degree program students have a limited number of books they can purchase on their own because the school uses student learning management systems, and they required electronic textbooks to be integrated within the system. Starting with the class start on March 19, 2024, the Medical Clinical Assistant program is transitioning to electronic books for all courses.
- Laptop Computer: Students have the option to purchase a laptop computer through the college.
- Extra/Replacement Uniforms: For programs that require uniforms, extra/replacement uniforms can be purchased through the college. Students should see the campus Bursar for more information.
- Bookstore Refund Policy: Some textbooks (printed or electronic) are not returnable. The campus can provide more information. Other consumables may be non-refundable if the student has consumed or used textbooks (printed or electronic) and/or program's uniforms and/or kits. If a student accesses the electronic book's code before the course begins, it is considered used. Other considerations to determine if a consumable item can be returned are (1) Items that were special ordered for a particular student and cannot be used by or sold to another student; or (2) Items that were returned in a condition that prevents them from being used by or sold to new students. (3) Individually documented non- refundable fees for goods or services provided by third party vendors.

The student is responsible for the cost of the Ohio State Driver's License Permit needed prior to the first day of class. The student is responsible for the cost of the license permit. The CDL program does not qualify for Federal Title IV Funds.
