Valley College-Cleveland launched its first program in March 2019. The Practical Nursing program in Cleveland was launched in March 2020. The CDL program was launched in July 2020. The Veterinary Technician program first graduates graduated in August 2021. The Satellite location in Fairlawn launched its Practical Nursing program in July 2021. The programs' cohorts for ACCSC vary based on program length and allows the student to complete the program within 150% of the program length and have at least 3 months to find employment. The graduation rate varies by program and is based on program length. The benchmark for placement is 70% for all programs.

Licensure Pass Rate for the Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN)

The Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN) calculates licensure pass rates differently from ACCSC. The OBN reports the number of individuals who pass the NCLEX-PN examination on the *first* attempt throughout each calendar year. ACCSC's cohort is established using the students' start dates and the OBN uses the students' graduation dates. Additionally, the OBN's reported licensure pass rate combines both Valley College – Cleveland and Valley College – Fairlawn into a single calculation. The OBN's official pass rates for the College's Ohio campuses are indicated in the following table.
