Program Outcomes**

Valley College publicly reports its three-year VTNE pass rate for first-time candidates, as required by the AVMA Committee on Veterinary Technician Education and Activities (CVTEA).

Three-Year Veterinary Technician National Exam (VTNE) Pass Rate

Date range: January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2025

Number of first-time candidates: 52

Three-year VTNE pass percentage: 32.26%

Understanding the Reported Data

The VTNE outcomes shown above follow CVTEA reporting requirements:

- Timeframe reported reflects the most recent three-year period for which complete data are available.
- First-time candidates include graduates who attempted the VTNE for the first time during the reporting window.
- Pass-rate calculation uses the standard formula:

$$\{\text{Pass}\ \text{Rate}\} = \{\text{Number of first-time candidates who passed}\} \ / \ (\text{Total number of first-time candidates} * 100)$$

Graduation Rate: *To be posted by April 15, 2026, per CVTEA requirements*

Job-Placement Rate: *To be posted by April 15, 2026, per CVTEA requirements*

Note: CVTEA has announced new requirements for annual public reporting of graduation and job-placement rates. Programs will publish these outcomes upon release of CVTEA’s standardized definitions and survey tools.

Valley College posts the graduation rate and job-placement rates as reported to our national accreditation body, ACCSC, on our website.
