Terms and Conditions:

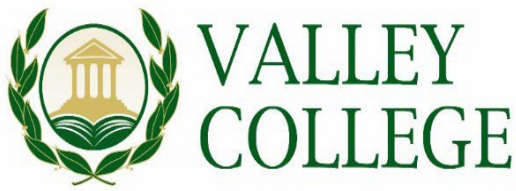
- Student must be a graduate of the Veterinary Assistant diploma program, having attended between April 2024 and March 2025.

- A student who transfers credits must have a minimum of 12 credits to complete in the chosen program to be eligible for the Scholarship.

3. Complete the application which includes an essay question. All information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant.
