



Student Financial Aid Rights and Responsibilities

Students receiving financial aid at Valley College have certain rights and responsibilities.

Student Rights

Students have the right to:

- Know what financial aid programs are available, including federal, state, and institutional aid
- Understand the application process and deadlines for each program
- Receive an explanation of how financial aid eligibility is determined
- Know the cost of attendance and how financial aid is awarded
- Be informed of the terms, conditions, and requirements of all financial aid awards
- Review and request reconsideration of their financial aid package

Student Responsibilities

Students receiving financial aid are responsible for:

- Completing all required application forms accurately and on time
- Providing additional documentation as requested
- Maintaining **Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** toward program completion
- Using financial aid funds only for educational expenses
- Notifying the institution of any changes in enrollment, financial status, or personal information
- Repaying any loans received in accordance with the terms of the promissory note
- Completing required loan entrance and exit counseling, if applicable
